The _____ Pistol Club applies to host the _____ State
Championships in the ISSF events on _____, in accordance with the following terms :

**SECTION A
HOST CLUB RESPONSIBILITIES**

- A 1. We agree to provide W.A.P.A. approved facilities to conduct 50m Pistol, Rapid Fire, Standard Pistol (Senior and Junior), Centre Fire, 25m Pistol (Women, Junior, WSPS) and Air Pistol (Men, Women, Junior, WSPS) events in accordance with the latest ISSF Regulations including Finals in all appropriate events.
- A 2. We agree to supply all target requirements and these targets will have been supplied by the W.A.P.A. Target Officer or have been approved by the State Referee Council.
- New targets will be supplied as follows:
- a. Every ten (10) shots in 50m Pistol and Standard Pistol and the Precision stage of Centre Fire and the 25m Pistol events.
 - b. Two (2) International Rapid Fire target for every competitor in the rapid fire stage of Centre Fire and the 25m Pistol events. To be changed after the 3rd rapid fire series.
 - c. Five (5) International Rapid Fire targets for every set of targets after three competitors on that set in the Rapid Fire event.
 - d. One (1) target for every shot in all Air Pistol matches (except sighters).
 - e. Kruger or Edelman Air Pistol Targets to be used.
- A 3. Backing targets will be provided and used in all applicable matches in accordance with ISSF Regulations - matches being Centre Fire, 25m Pistol, Standard Pistol, 50m Pistol. They must be continuous, or on adjoining frames, without any spaces between them.
- A 4. Suitable patching material (for efficient use on both wet or dry targets) will be supplied and used.
- A 5. The Pistol Australia scoring system will be used for all matches.
- A 6. We agree not to start any matches before 7.30 am.
- A 7. We agree to be responsible for the squadding and sending out of all squad cards.
- A 8. Wherever possible, turning target ranges will be under the supervision of Pistol Australia qualified Range Officers.
- A 9. We will supply all catering and toilet facilities.

- A 10. We will receive all relevant fees, deduct the shooter/event charges and pay the balance to W.A.P.A. within four (4) weeks of the completion of the Championships.
- A 11. Our Equipment Control Officer will be on the range each day at least 1 hour prior to the commencement of the first detail of shooting to check and stamp all pistols before they may be used in the competition. The officer will also open the Checking Station on the evening prior to the Championships for a period of two (2) hours.
- Our Equipment Control Officer will be appointed in liaison with the S.R.C Director.
- A.12 Finals: We agree to allow one (1) hours notice between the last shot fired and competitors reporting to the range for all Finals.
A minimum of 20 minutes must be allowed between posting scores and competitors reporting to the range, thus allowing ample time for protests.
- A 13. We will supply a Presentation Dais for 1st, 2nd and 3rd Place.
- A 14. We will be responsible for the collation and processing of scores under the supervision of the Range Jury, including the determination of medal winners, aggregates and team scores as advised by WAPA.
- A 15. We agree to supply the competitors, W.A.P.A. Secretary and Editor of the Magazine with a complete list of results on the final day of competition.

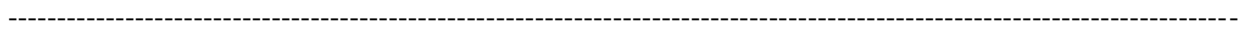

**SECTION A
HOST CLUB RESPONSIBILITIES**

- A 1. We agree to provide W.A.P.A. approved facilities to conduct the above matches in accordance with the Pistol Australia Regulations and W.A.P.A. variations to such regulations.
- A 2. We agree to provide all the target requirements. These targets will have been supplied either by the W.A.P.A Target Officer or have been approved by the State Referee Council.

SERVICE PISTOL MATCHES

- a. One new set of targets (four 4) for every competitor at 50 yards and also at 25 yards if the match is shot on different ranges.
- b. Backing targets will be used in accordance with Pistol Australia Regulations ie: complete cover, preferred continuous *cardboard* roll.
- c. Suitable patching material (for efficient use on both wet and dry targets) will be supplied and used.

BLACK POWDER MATCHES

- a. One new ISSF Precision target for every five (5) shots in 25 metre match.
 - b. One new Service Pistol target for every competitor in the rapid fire stage of the 25 metre match.
 - c. One new 50 metre Black Powder target for every ten (10) shots in the 50 metre match.
 - d. Backing targets will be used in accordance with Pistol Australia Regulations ie: complete cover, preferred continuous *cardboard* roll.
 - e. Suitable patching material (for efficient use on both wet and dry targets) will be supplied and used.
- A 3. We agree to use Pistol Australia scoring system.
 - A 4. For Service Pistol on all ranges being used we will provide a roped off staging area.

- A 5. For Service Pistol a designated *Safe Area* will be provided. A sign will be prominently displayed in this area, stating:
* **SAFE AREA, NO AMMUNITION ALLOWED, DRY FIRE ONLY***
- A 6. We will have a reasonable supply of safety glasses available if required.
- A 7. Supply 8' x 3' mats (not nylon) for the 50yd & 25yd position in the Practical events & 25yd position in the Plates event.
- A 8. Wherever possible, turning target ranges will be under the supervision of Pistol Australia qualified Range Officers.
- A 9. We agree not to start any matches before 7.30 a.m.
- A 10. We agree to be responsible for all the squadding and the distribution of the squad cards.
- A 11. We agree to have at least two (2) details each of Black Powder 50 metres and 25 metres.
- A 12. All precision must be completed before the rapid fire stage commences.
- A 13. For Service Pistol our nominated Chronographing Officer will be fully conversant with the correct operation of the WAPA supplied chronograph.
- We will use new or fully re-charged batteries and will provide a suitable area for chronographing all loads under the supervision of the Range Jury.
- Our Chronographing Officer will be appointed in liaison with the S.R.C.
- A 14. Our Equipment Control Officer agrees to be on the range each day one (1) hour prior to the commencement of the first detail to check all equipment and holster cards as per Pistol Australia Regulations. Our Equipment Control Officer will be appointed in liaison with the Director of the S.R.C.
- A 15. We will supply a Presentation Dais for 1st, 2nd and 3rd Place.
- A 16. We will be responsible for the collation and processing of scores under the supervision of the Range Jury, including the determination of medal winners, aggregates and team scores as advised by WAPA.
- A 17. We agree to supply the competitors, W.A.P.A. Secretary and Editor of the Magazine with a complete list of results on the final day of competition.
- A 18. We will receive all relevant fees, deduct the shooter/event charges and pay the balance to W.A.P.A. within four (4) weeks of the completion of the Championships.
